- 4 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 1.** A new section is added to chapter 49.17 RCW 5 to read as follows:
- 6 New ergonomic rules proposed for adoption by the department may be

- RCW 34.05.313. The group of pilot project employers selected shall be
