- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 5 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 1.** A new section is added to chapter 28A.320 6 RCW to read as follows:
- 7 (1) Beginning with the 2000-01 school year, the superintendent of
- 8 public instruction shall notify high schools of the names and contact
- 9 information of public and private entities offering programs leading to
- 10 college credit, if the superintendent has knowledge of such entities
- 11 and if the cost of reporting these entities is minimal.
- 12 (2) Beginning with the 2000-01 school year, each high school shall
- 13 publish annually and deliver to each parent with children enrolled in
- 14 the school, information concerning the entrance requirements and the
- 15 availability in the school of programs leading to college credit, such
- 16 as advanced placement and international baccalaureate programs. In
- 17 addition, each high school shall enclose information of the names and
- 18 contact information of other public or private entities offering such
- 19 programs, including on-line advanced placement programs, to high school
