1 AN ACT Relating to allotments for school plant facilities by the
2 state board of education; and amending RCW 28A.525.168.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

4 **Sec. 1.** RCW 28A.525.168 and 1990 c 33 s 458 are each amended to
5 read as follows:

6 After January 1, 1998, whenever the voters of a school district
7 authorize the issuance of bonds and/or the levying of excess taxes in
8 an amount sufficient to meet the requirements of RCW 28A.525.162
9 respecting eligibility for state assistance in providing school
10 facilities, the taxable valuation of the district and the percentage of
11 state assistance in providing school facilities prevailing at the time
12 of such authorization shall be the valuation and the percentage used
13 for the purpose of determining the eligibility of the district for an
14 allotment of state funds and the amount or amounts of such allotments,
15 respectively, for all projects for which the voters authorize capital
16 funds as aforesaid, unless a higher percentage of state assistance
17 prevails during the preceding calendar year or on the date that state
18 funds for assistance in financing a project are allotted by the state
19 board of education in which case the percentage prevailing on the date

1 of allotment by the state board of funds for each project shall govern:
2 PROVIDED, That if the state board of education determines at any time
3 that there has been undue or unwarranted delay on the part of school
4 district authorities in advancing a project to the point of readiness
5 for an allotment of state funds, the taxable valuation of the school
6 district and the percentage of state assistance prevailing on the date
7 that the allotment is made shall be used for the purposes aforesaid:
8 PROVIDED, FURTHER, That the date herein specified as applicable in
9 determining the eligibility of an individual school district for state
10 assistance and in determining the amount of such assistance shall be
11 applicable also to cases where it is necessary in administering chapter
12 28A.540 RCW to determine eligibility for and the amount of state
13 assistance for a group of school districts considered as a single
14 school administrative unit.
