- 4 **Sec. 1.** RCW 41.32.4986 and 1999 c 362 s 1 are each amended to read 5 as follows:
- 6 A member may make the irrevocable election under this section no
- 7 later than six months after attaining thirty years of service. The
- 8 election shall become effective at the beginning of the calendar month
- 9 following department receipt of employee notification.
- 10 (1) The sum of both the member contributions made ((for periods of
- 11 service after the effective date of the election plus seven and one-
- 12 half percent interest)) after the thirtieth year of service plus all
- 13 interest credited after the thirtieth year of service on all of the
- 14 member's contributions shall be paid to the member at retirement
- 15 without a reduction in the member's monthly retirement benefit as

- 6 (3) Members who have already earned thirty years of service credit 7 prior to July 25, 1999, may participate in the election by notifying 8 the department in writing of their intention by December 31, 1999.
- 9 The department shall continue to collect employer contributions as 10 required in RCW 41.45.060.
- 11 **Sec. 2.** RCW 41.40.191 and 1999 c 362 s 2 are each amended to read 12 as follows:
- A member may make the irrevocable election under this section no later than six months after attaining thirty years of service. The election shall become effective at the beginning of the calendar month following department receipt of employee notification.
  - (1) The sum of <u>both the</u> member contributions made ((<del>for periods of service after the effective date of the election plus seven and one-half percent interest</del>)) after the thirtieth year of service plus all <u>interest credited after the thirtieth year of service on all of the member's contributions</u> shall be paid to the member at retirement without a reduction in the member's monthly retirement benefit as determined under RCW 41.40.185.
  - (2) Upon retirement, the member's benefit shall be calculated using only the compensation earnable credited prior to the effective date of the member's election. Calculation of the member's average final compensation shall include eligible cash outs of sick and annual leave based on the member's salary and leave accumulations at the time of retirement, except that the amount of a member's average final compensation cannot be higher than if the member had not taken advantage of the election offered under this section.
- 32 (3) Members who have already earned thirty years of service credit 33 prior to July 25, 1999, may participate in the election by notifying 34 the department in writing of their intention by December 31, 1999.
- The department shall continue to collect employer contributions as required in RCW 41.45.060.
