- 4 **Sec. 1.** RCW 43.330.092 and 1997 c 220 s 222 are each amended to 5 read as follows:
- 6  $\underline{\text{(1)}}$  The film and video promotion account is created in the state
- 7 treasury. All receipts from RCW 36.102.060(14) must be deposited into
- 8 the account. Moneys in the account may be spent only after
- 9 appropriation. Expenditures from the account may be used by the
- 10 department of community, trade, and economic development only for the
- 11 purposes of promotion of the film and video production industry in the
- 12 state of Washington.
- 13 (2)(a) Any commercial or advertisement that is produced by or on
- 14 behalf of a state agency, and that uses film, video, or other form of
- 15 live action media, must be filmed in Washington state.
- 16 (b) If a state agency determines that it is not possible to comply
- 17 with (a) of this subsection, then the state agency must receive express
