- 1 AN ACT Relating to Lake Whatcom; creating new sections; and making
- 2 an appropriation.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 4 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 1.** The Lake Whatcom landscape management pilot 5 project is created.
- 6 The department of natural resources shall develop a landscape plan
- 7 regarding state-owned forest lands in the Lake Whatcom watershed area.
- 8 Where appropriate, the department will consult with other major forest
- 9 landowners in the watershed and shall involve watershed residents in
- 10 management activities. The department shall consult with the Lake
- 11 Whatcom management committee on proposed timber harvest and road
- 12 management activities. The department may establish an
- 13 interjurisdictional committee to review the site-specific activities
- 14 and make recommendations. The interjurisdictional committee shall
- 15 include two members of the public who have an interest in these
- 16 activities. The landscape plan shall address at least the following
- 17 topics:
- 18 (1) Establishing riparian management zones along all streams, as
- 19 classified under chapter 5, Laws of 1999 sp. sess. The department

- 1 shall manage lands within such zones to protect water quality and
- 2 riparian habitat, and interdisciplinary technical teams may recommend
- 3 to the department restrictions upon timber harvest and yarding
- 4 activities on a case-by-case basis;
- 5 (2) Harvest and road construction upon unstable slopes should be
- 6 carefully regulated, including limiting new road construction and old
- 7 road reconstruction on unstable slopes, including windthrow buffers
- 8 during harvest, as necessary;
- 9 (3) Creating and implementing a sustainable yield model specific to
- 10 the Lake Whatcom watershed that encompasses the revised management
- 11 standards and that is consistent with the sustained yield established
- 12 by the board of natural resources;
- 13 (4) The department should build on the existing draft Lake Whatcom
- 14 landscape plan and incorporate both new information from the community
- 15 and new scientific information when available; and
- 16 (5) The development of a road management plan for the watershed.
- 17 The landscape plan shall be completed and implementation initiated
- 18 by June 30, 2001. Timber harvest in the watershed on state land shall
- 19 be delayed until the plan is completed.
- 20 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 2.** The sum of two million dollars, or as much
- 21 thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated for the biennium ending
- 22 June 30, 2001, from the forest development account to the department of
- 23 natural resources to expedite the development and implementation of
- 24 road management for the Lake Whatcom watershed. The plan is to be
- 25 completed by December 31, 2001, and implementation shall begin
- 26 immediately upon completion.
- 27 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 3.** If specific funding for the purposes of
- 28 section 2 of this act, referencing section 2 of this act by bill or
- 29 chapter number or section number, is not provided by June 30, 2000, in
- 30 the omnibus appropriations act, section 2 of this act is null and void.
