- 1 AN ACT Relating to service credit for a member of the Washington

- 5 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 1.** A new section is added to chapter 43.43 RCW 6 to read as follows:
- 7 (1) A member who is on a paid leave of absence authorized by a 8 member's employer shall continue to receive service credit as provided 9 under the provisions of RCW 43.43.120 through 43.43.310.
- (2) A member who receives compensation from an employer while on an authorized leave of absence to serve as an elected official of a labor organization, and whose employer is reimbursed by the labor organization for the compensation paid to the member during the period
- 14 of absence, may also be considered to be on a paid leave of absence.
- 15 This subsection shall only apply if the member's leave of absence is
- 16 authorized by a collective bargaining agreement that provides that the
- 17 member retains seniority rights with the employer during the period of
- 18 leave. The basic salary reported for a member who establishes service
- 19 credit under this subsection may not be greater than the salary paid to

- 1 the highest paid job class covered by the collective bargaining 2 agreement.
- NEW SECTION. Sec. 2. Section 1 of this act applies on a retroactive basis to members for whom compensation and hours were reported under the circumstances described in section 1 of this act. Section 1 of this act may also be applied on a retroactive basis to November 23, 1987, to members for whom compensation and hours would have been reported except for explicit instructions from the department of retirement systems.
