- 1 AN ACT Relating to organ donations; adding a new section to chapter
- 2 68.50 RCW; and making an appropriation.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 4 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 1.** A new section is added to chapter 68.50 RCW 5 to read as follows:
- 6 (1) The definitions in this subsection apply throughout this 7 section unless the context clearly requires otherwise.
- 8 (a) "Department" means the department of social and health 9 services.
- 10 (b) "Medical entity" means a hospital, organ bank, organ donation 11 organization, coroner, medical examiner, or other entity specified by 12 the department by rule.
- 13 (2) The organ donor data base program is created in the department.
- 14 The purpose of the program is to create and maintain a secure data base
- 15 that lists volunteer organ donors in the state. The goal of the
- 16 program is to increase the availability of donated organs, and to make
- 17 the process of donating and receiving organs more timely and efficient.
- 18 (3) The department must create an on-line data base containing
- 19 information about all eligible individuals who have volunteered as

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- lorgan donors in the state. The data base must be in a format that will
- 2 allow the department to enter and update information easily and cost
- 3 effectively, and allow authorized medical entities to access the data
- 4 base twenty-four hours a day. The data base must be private, and
- 5 accessible only to those medical entities authorized by the department
- 6 by rule.
- 7 (4) Information for the data base may come from existing public and
- 8 private organ donor lists or data bases. Information may also come
- 9 from a volunteer organ donor form created by the department. The
- 10 department must adopt by rule the content of the form to be filled out
- 11 by a volunteer organ donor. At a minimum, the form must include the
- 12 following:
- 13 (a) The name, address, telephone number, and date of birth of the
- 14 volunteer organ donor; and
- 15 (b) A space on the form that requires the volunteer organ donor to
- 16 communicate his or her wish to be an organ donor to another person over
- 17 age eighteen. The witness shall also provide his or her name, address,
- 18 and phone number, and sign the form signifying his or her understanding
- 19 of the volunteer organ donor's intent.
- 20 (5) The department must adopt by rule procedures for the broad
- 21 dissemination and timely retrieval of volunteer organ donation forms,
- 22 as well as the method and timing of entering new or updated organ donor
- 23 information into the data base.
- 24 (6) The department is authorized to adopt rules necessary to
- 25 implement this section.
- NEW SECTION. Sec. 2. The sum of dollars, or as much
- 27 thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated for the fiscal year ending
- 28 June 30, 2001, from the general fund to the department of social and
- 29 health services for the purposes of this act.

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
