BE IT RESOLVED, By the Senate of the State of Washington, the House
of Representatives concurring, That immediately before adjournment SINE
DIE of this 1999 Regular session of the Fifty-sixth Legislature:

4 (1) The Senate shall transmit to the House of Representatives all 5 House bills, House joint resolutions, House concurrent resolutions, and 6 House joint memorials in its possession that have not been passed by 7 the Senate, and upon receipt by the House of Representatives of such 8 measures they shall be assigned to the House Rules Committee for third 9 reading; and

10 (2) The House of Representatives shall transmit to the Senate all 11 Senate bills, Senate joint resolutions, Senate concurrent resolutions, 12 and Senate joint memorials in its possession that have not been passed 13 by the House of Representatives, and upon receipt by the Senate of such 14 measures they shall be assigned to the Senate Rules Committee for third 15 reading; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Secretary of the Senate and the Co-Chief Clerks of the House of Representatives shall retain in their possession and in the status that exists upon the adjournment SINE DIE of the 1999 Regular session of the Fifty-sixth Legislature, all legislative measures including all bills, joint resolutions, concurrent resolutions, and joint memorials that may at that time be in their

1 respective houses and all records, journals, dockets, and other 2 documents pertaining thereto; and

3 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That all measures introduced at any special 4 session of the Fifty-sixth Legislature shall be numbered as a 5 continuation of the numbers assigned to measures of the 1999 Regular 6 session of the Fifty-sixth Legislature.
