- 1 AN ACT Relating to unfair trade practices regarding business
- 2 telephone listings; and adding a new chapter to Title 19 RCW.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 4 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 1.** The definitions in this section apply throughout this chapter unless the context clearly requires otherwise.
- (1) "Local telephone directory" means a publication listing telephone numbers for various businesses in a certain geographic area and distributed free of charge to some or all telephone subscribers in
- 9 that area.
- 10 (2) "Local telephone number" means a telephone number that can be
- 11 dialed without incurring long distance charges from telephones located
- 12 within the area covered by the local telephone directory in which the
- 13 number is listed. The term does not include long distance numbers,
- 14 toll-free numbers, or 900 exchange numbers listed in a local telephone
- 15 directory.
- 16 (3) "Person" means an individual, partnership, limited liability
- 17 partnership, corporation, or limited liability corporation.

- 1 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 2.** No person engaged in the selling, delivery,
- 2 or solicitation of cut flowers, flower arrangements, or floral products
- 3 may misrepresent his, her, or its geographic location by:
- 4 (1) Listing a local telephone number in a local telephone directory 5 if:
- 6 (a) Calls to the telephone number are routinely forwarded or 7 otherwise transferred to a business location that is outside the 8 calling area covered by the local telephone directory; and
- 9 (b) The listing fails to conspicuously disclose the locality and 10 state in which the business is located; or
- 11 (2) Listing a business name in a local telephone directory if:
- 12 (a) The name misrepresents the business's geographic location; and
- 13 (b) The listing fails to disclose the locality and state in which
- 14 the business is located.
- 15 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 3.** The legislature finds that the practices
- 16 covered by this chapter are matters vitally affecting the public
- 17 interest for the purpose of applying the consumer protection act,
- 18 chapter 19.86 RCW. Violations of this chapter are not reasonable in
- 19 relation to the development and preservation of business. A violation
- 20 of this chapter is an unfair or deceptive act in trade or commerce and
- 21 an unfair method of competition for the purpose of applying the
- 22 consumer protection act, chapter 19.86 RCW.
- 23 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 4.** Sections 1 through 3 of this act constitute
- 24 a new chapter in Title 19 RCW.
