- 1 (1) To maintain records of all activities, and to publish and 2 distribute to all psychologists at least once each year abstracts of 3 significant activities of the committee; ((and))
- 4 (2) To obtain the written consent of the complaining client or 5 patient or their legal representative, or of any person who may be affected by the complaint, in order to obtain information which otherwise might be confidential or privileged; and
- 8 (3) To apply the provisions of the uniform disciplinary act,
 9 chapter 18.130 RCW, to all persons licensed as psychologists under this
