1 AN ACT Relating to regulation of outflow of lakes; and amending RCW 2 90.24.010.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

4 Sec. 1. RCW 90.24.010 and 1985 c 398 s 28 are each amended to read 5 as follows:

6 Ten or more owners of real property abutting on a ((meandered)) 7 lake may petition the superior court of the county in which the lake is situated, for an order to provide for the regulation of the outflow of 8 the lake in order to maintain a certain water level therein. If there 9 10 are fewer than ten owners, a majority of the owners abutting on a lake may petition the superior court for such an order. The court, after 11 notice to the department of fish and wildlife and a hearing, is 12 13 authorized to make an order fixing the water level thereof and 14 directing the department of ecology to regulate the outflow therefrom 15 in accordance with the purposes described in the petition. This section shall not apply to any ((meandered)) lake or reservoir used for 16 17 the storage of water for irrigation or other beneficial purposes, or to lakes navigable from the sea. 18
