1            AN ACT Relating to wildlife publications; adding a new section to  
2 chapter 77.12 RCW; and repealing RCW 77.12.185 and 75.08.235.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

4            NEW SECTION.    **Sec. 1.** A new section is added to chapter 77.12 RCW  
5 to read as follows:

6            (1) The department shall deposit all moneys received from the  
7 following activities into the state wildlife fund:

8            (a) The sale of interpretive, recreational, historical,  
9 educational, and informational literature and materials;

10           (b) The sale of advertisements in regulation pamphlets and other  
11 appropriate mediums; and

12           (c) Enrollment fees in department-sponsored educational training  
13 events.

14           (2) Moneys collected under subsection (1) of this section shall be  
15 spent primarily for producing regulation booklets for users and for the  
16 development, production, reprinting, and distribution of informational  
17 and educational materials. The department may also spend these moneys  
18 for necessary expenses associated with training activities, and other  
19 activities as determined by the director.

1 (3) Regulation pamphlets may be subsidized through appropriate  
2 advertising, but must be made available free of charge to the users.

3 (4) The director may enter into joint ventures with other agencies  
4 and organizations to generate revenue for providing public information  
5 and education on wildlife and hunting and fishing rules.

6 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 2.** RCW 77.12.185 (Publications--Authority to  
7 recover costs--Disposition of moneys) and 1987 c 506 s 26, 1980 c 78 s  
8 66, & 1979 c 56 s 2 are each repealed.

9 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 3.** RCW 75.08.235 (Informational materials--Fee-  
10 Disposition of money collected) and 1992 c 13 s 12 are each repealed.
