4 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 2.** A new section is added to chapter 44.04 RCW
5 to read as follows:

6 The chief clerk of the house of representatives may authorize
7 surplus computers and computer-related equipment owned by the house,
8 the secretary of the senate may authorize surplus computers and
9 computer-related equipment owned by the senate, and the directors of
10 legislative agencies may authorize surplus computers and computer-
11 related equipment owned by his or her respective agency, to be donated
12 to school districts and educational service districts. This section
13 shall not be construed to limit the discretion of the legislature
14 regarding disposal of its surplus property.
