AN ACT Relating to custodial sexual misconduct; amending RCW 43.43.830 and 70.125.030; reenacting and amending RCW 9.94A.320; adding new sections to chapter 9A.44 RCW; adding a new section to chapter 72.09 RCW; and prescribing penalties.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

6 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> Sec. 1. A new section is added to chapter 9A.44 RCW 7 to read as follows:

8 (1) A person is guilty of custodial sexual misconduct in the first 9 degree when the person has sexual intercourse with another person: 10 (a) When:

(i) The victim is a resident of a state, county, or city adult or juvenile correctional facility, including but not limited to jails, prisons, detention centers, or work release facilities, or is under correctional supervision; and

(ii) The perpetrator is an employee or contract personnel of a correctional agency and the perpetrator has, or the victim reasonably believes the perpetrator has, the ability to influence the terms, conditions, length, or fact of incarceration or correctional supervision; or

1 (b) When the victim is being detained, under arrest or in the 2 custody of a law enforcement officer and the perpetrator is a law 3 enforcement officer.

4 (2) Consent of the victim is not a defense to a prosecution under 5 this section.

6 (3) Custodial sexual misconduct in the first degree is a class C 7 felony.

8 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 2.** A new section is added to chapter 9A.44 RCW 9 to read as follows:

(1) A person is guilty of custodial sexual misconduct in the seconddegree when the person has sexual contact with another person:

12 (a) When:

(i) The victim is a resident of a state, county, or city adult or
juvenile correctional facility, including but not limited to jails,
prisons, detention centers, or work release facilities, or is under
correctional supervision; and

(ii) The perpetrator is an employee or contract personnel of a correctional agency and the perpetrator has, or the victim reasonably believes the perpetrator has, the ability to influence the terms, conditions, length, or fact of incarceration or correctional supervision; or

(b) When the victim is being detained, under arrest, or in the custody of a law enforcement officer and the perpetrator is a law enforcement officer.

(2) Consent of the victim is not a defense to a prosecution underthis section.

(3) Custodial sexual misconduct in the second degree is a grossmisdemeanor.

29 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 3.** A new section is added to chapter 9A.44 RCW 30 to read as follows:

It is an affirmative defense to prosecution under section 1 or 2 of this act, to be proven by the defendant by a preponderance of the evidence, that the act of sexual intercourse or sexual contact resulted from forcible compulsion by the other person.

8 (3) "Civil adjudication" means a specific court finding of sexual 9 abuse or exploitation or physical abuse in a dependency action under RCW 13.34.040 or in a domestic relations action under Title 26 RCW. In 10 the case of vulnerable adults, civil adjudication means a specific 11 court finding of abuse or financial exploitation in a protection 12 proceeding under chapter 74.34 RCW. It does not include administrative 13 proceedings. The term "civil adjudication" is further limited to court 14 15 findings that identify as the perpetrator of the abuse a named 16 individual, over the age of eighteen years, who was a party to the dependency or dissolution proceeding or was a respondent in a 17 protection proceeding in which the finding was made and who contested 18 19 the allegation of abuse or exploitation.

(4) "Conviction record" means "conviction record" information as 20 defined in RCW 10.97.030(3) relating to a crime against children or 21 other persons committed by either an adult or a juvenile. minor; unlawful imprisonment; simple assault; sexual exploitation of 1 minors; first or second degree criminal mistreatment; child abuse or 2 neglect as defined in RCW 26.44.020; first or second degree custodial 3 4 interference; first or second degree custodial sexual misconduct; malicious harassment; first, second, or third degree child molestation; 5 first or second degree sexual misconduct with a minor; patronizing a б 7 juvenile prostitute; child abandonment; promoting pornography; selling 8 or distributing erotic material to a minor; custodial assault; 9 violation of child abuse restraining order; child buying or selling; 10 prostitution; felony indecent exposure; criminal abandonment; or any of these crimes as they may be renamed in the future. 11

(6) "Crimes relating to drugs" means a conviction of a crime to
manufacture, delivery, or possession with intent to manufacture or
deliver a controlled substance.

(7) "Crimes relating to financial exploitation" means a conviction for first, second, or third degree extortion; first, second, or third degree theft; first or second degree robbery; forgery; or any of these crimes as they may be renamed in the future.

19 (8) "Disciplinary board final decision" means any final decision 20 issued by a disciplining authority under chapter 18.130 RCW or the 21 secretary of the department of health for the following businesses or 22 professions:

23 (a) Chiropractic;

- 24 (b) Dentistry;
- 25 (c) Dental hygiene;
- 26 (d) Massage;
- 27 (e) Midwifery;
- 28 (f) Naturopathy;
- 29 (g) Osteopathic medicine and surgery;

38 (9) "Unsupervised" means not in the presence of:

(a) Another employee or volunteer from the same business or
 organization as the applicant; or

3 (b) Any relative or guardian of any of the children or 4 developmentally disabled persons or vulnerable adults to which the 5 applicant has access during the course of his or her employment or 6 involvement with the business or organization.

7 (10) "Vulnerable adult" means "vulnerable adult" as defined in 8 chapter 74.34 RCW, except that for the purposes of requesting and 9 receiving background checks pursuant to RCW 43.43.832, it shall also 10 include adults of any age who lack the functional, mental, or physical 11 ability to care for themselves.

(11) "Financial exploitation" means the illegal or improper use of
a vulnerable adult or that adult's resources for another person's
profit or advantage.

(12) "Agency" means any person, firm, partnership, association,
corporation, or facility which receives, provides services to, houses
or otherwise cares for vulnerable adults.

18 Sec. 6. RCW 70.125.030 and 1996 c 123 s 6 are each amended to read 19 as follows:

As used in this chapter and unless the context indicates otherwise: (1) "Core services" means treatment services for victims of sexual assault including information and referral, crisis intervention, medical advocacy, legal advocacy, support, and system coordination.

(2) "Department" means the department of community, trade, andeconomic development.

26 (3) "Law enforcement agencies" means police and sheriff's27 departments of this state.

(4) "Personal representative" means a friend, relative, attorney,
 or employee or volunteer from a community sexual assault program or
 specialized treatment service provider.

(5) "Rape crisis center" means a community-based social serviceagency which provides services to victims of sexual assault.

33 (6) "Community sexual assault program" means a community-based 34 social service agency that is qualified to provide and provides core 35 services to victims of sexual assault.

36 (7) "Sexual assault" means one or more of the following:

37 (a) Rape or rape of a child;

38 (b) Assault with intent to commit rape or rape of a child;

1 (c) Incest or indecent liberties;

2 (d) Child molestation;

3 (e) Sexual misconduct with a minor;

4 (f) <u>Custodial sexual misconduct;</u>

5 (g) Crimes with a sexual motivation; or

(9) "Victim" means any person who suffers physical and/or mentalanguish as a proximate result of a sexual assault.

14 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> Sec. 7. A new section is added to chapter 72.09 RCW 15 to read as follows:

The department shall investigate any alleged violations of section 17 1 or 2 of this act that are alleged to have been committed by an 18 employee or contract personnel of the department, to determine whether 19 there is probable cause to believe that the allegation is true before 20 reporting the alleged violation to a prosecuting attorney.
