- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 4 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 1.** A new section is added to chapter 77.12 RCW 5 to read as follows:
- 6 (1) The department shall deposit all moneys received from the 7 following activities into the state wildlife fund:
- 8 (a) The sale of interpretive, recreational, historical, 9 educational, and informational literature and materials;
- 10 (b) The sale of advertisements in regulation pamphlets and other 11 appropriate mediums; and
- 12 (c) Enrollment fees in department-sponsored educational training 13 events.
- 14 (2) Moneys collected under subsection (1) of this section shall be
- 15 spent primarily for producing regulation booklets for users and for the
- 16 development, production, reprinting, and distribution of informational
- 17 and educational materials. The department may also spend these moneys
- 18 for necessary expenses associated with training activities, and other
- 19 activities as determined by the director.

- 1 (3) Regulation pamphlets may be subsidized through appropriate
- 2 advertising, but must be made available free of charge to the users.
- 3 (4) The director may enter into joint ventures with other agencies
- 4 and organizations to generate revenue for providing public information
- 5 and education on wildlife and hunting and fishing rules.
