б (1) Habitat project lists shall be submitted to the salmon recovery 7 funding board for funding ((by January 1st and July 1st of each year beginning in 2000)) at least once a year on a schedule established by 8 9 The board shall provide the legislature with a list of the the board. 10 proposed projects and a list of the projects funded by October 1st of each year ((beginning in 2000)) for informational purposes. 11 Project sponsors who complete salmon habitat projects approved for funding from 12 13 habitat project lists and have met grant application deadlines will be 14 paid by the salmon recovery funding board within thirty days of project 15 completion.

(2) The interagency committee for outdoor recreation shall track
all funds allocated for salmon habitat projects and salmon recovery
activities on behalf of the board, including both funds allocated by

1 the board and funds allocated by other state or federal agencies for 2 salmon recovery or water quality improvement.
