1 AN ACT Relating to the salmon recovery funding board's reporting of
2 financial affairs; and amending RCW 42.17.2401.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

4 **Sec. 1.** RCW 42.17.2401 and 1996 c 186 s 504 are each amended to
5 read as follows:

6 For the purposes of RCW 42.17.240, the term "executive state
7 officer" includes:

8 (1) The chief administrative law judge, the director of
9 agriculture, (~~the administrator of the office of marine safety,~~) the
10 administrator of the Washington basic health plan, the director of the
11 department of services for the blind, the director of the state system
12 of community and technical colleges, the director of community, trade,

16 finance committee, the director of financial management, the director
17 of fish and wildlife, the executive secretary of the forest practices
18 appeals board, the director of the gambling commission, the director of
19 general administration, the secretary of health, the administrator of

1 the Washington state health care authority, the executive secretary of
2 the health care facilities authority, the executive secretary of the
3 higher education facilities authority, the executive secretary of the
4 horse racing commission, the executive secretary of the human rights
5 commission, the executive secretary of the indeterminate sentence
6 review board, the director of the department of information services,
7 the director of the interagency committee for outdoor recreation, the
8 executive director of the state investment board, the director of labor
9 and industries, the director of licensing, the director of the lottery
