- 1 AN ACT Relating to expressions of benevolence, sympathy, and
- 2 regret; and adding a new chapter to Title 5 RCW.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 4 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 1.** (1) The portion of statements, writings, or
- 5 benevolent gestures expressing sympathy or a general sense of
- 6 benevolence relating to the pain, suffering, or death of a person
- 7 involved in an accident, and made to that person or to the family of
- 8 that person, shall be inadmissible as evidence in a civil action. A
- 9 statement of fault, however, which is part of, or in addition to, any
- 10 of the above shall not be made inadmissible by this section.
- 11 (2) For purposes of this section:
- 12 (a) "Accident" means an occurrence resulting in injury or death to
- 13 one or more persons that is not the result of willful action by a
- 14 party.
- 15 (b) "Benevolent gestures" means actions that convey a sense of
- 16 compassion or commiseration emanating from humane impulses.
- 17 (c) "Family" means the spouse, parent, grandparent, stepmother,
- 18 stepfather, child, grandchild, brother, sister, half brother, half

- 1 sister, adopted child of a parent, or spouse's parents of an injured 2 party.
- 3 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 2.** Section 1 of this act constitutes a new
- 4 chapter in Title 5 RCW.
