1            AN ACT Relating to reimbursement of members and employees of  
2 commodity boards and commissions; and amending RCW 15.65.270 and  
3 15.66.130.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

5            **Sec. 1.** RCW 15.65.270 and 1984 c 287 s 16 are each amended to read  
6 as follows:

7            In the event of a vacancy on the board, the remaining members shall  
8 select a qualified person to fill the unexpired term. A majority of  
9 the voting members of the board shall constitute a quorum for the  
10 transaction of all business and the carrying out of all duties of the  
11 board. Each member of the board shall be compensated in accordance  
12 with RCW 43.03.230 (~~and shall~~). Members and employees of the board  
13 may be reimbursed for actual travel expenses incurred in carrying out  
14 the provisions of this chapter, as defined under the commodity board's  
15 marketing order. Otherwise, if not defined or referenced in the  
16 marketing order, reimbursement for travel expenses shall be at the  
17 rates allowed state employees in accordance with RCW 43.03.050 and  
18 43.03.060.

1       **Sec. 2.** RCW 15.66.130 and 1984 c 287 s 17 are each amended to read  
2 as follows:

3       Each commodity commission shall hold such regular meetings as the  
4 marketing order may prescribe or that the commission by resolution may  
5 prescribe, together with such special meetings that may be called in  
6 accordance with provisions of its resolutions upon reasonable notice to  
7 all members thereof. A majority of the members shall constitute a  
8 quorum for the transaction of all business of the commission. In the  
9 event of a vacancy in an elected or appointed position on the  
10 commission, the remaining elected members of the commission shall  
11 select a qualified person to fill the unexpired term.

12       Each member of the commission shall be compensated in accordance  
13 with RCW 43.03.230 (~~and shall~~). Members and employees of the  
14 commission may be reimbursed for actual travel expenses incurred in  
15 carrying out the provisions of this chapter, as defined under the  
16 commodity board's marketing order. Otherwise, if not defined or  
17 referenced in the marketing order, reimbursement for travel expenses  
18 shall be in accordance with RCW 43.03.050 and 43.03.060.
