3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

4 **Sec. 1.** RCW 11.20.050 and 1967 c 168 s 17 are each amended to read  
5 as follows:

6 All wills (~~((shall be recorded by the clerk after filing, but))~~)  
7 filed with the clerk of the superior court must be noted in the record  
8 required to be kept under RCW 36.23.030(7). They may be withdrawn from  
9 the record on the order of the court.
