## HB 1039-S - DIGEST

## (AS OF HOUSE 2ND READING 2/22/01)

Finds that an ambiguity may exist regarding whether out-ofstate convictions or convictions under prior Washington law, for sex offenses that are comparable to current Washington offenses, count when determining whether an offender is a persistent offender.

Declares an intent to clarify the legislature's intent that out-of-state convictions for comparable sex offenses and prior Washington convictions for comparable sex offenses shall be used to determine whether an offender meets the definition of a persistent offender.
