Brief Description: Regulating advance health care directives.

HB 1299 - DIGEST

Provides that a principal with the decision-making capacity to do so may execute a psychiatric advance directive. A psychiatric advance directive may include one or more health care instructions to direct health care providers, others assisting with health care, family members, and a health care agent.

Authorizes a psychiatric advance directive to include a health care power of attorney to appoint a health care agent to make health care decisions for the principal when the principal, in the judgment of the principal's attending physician, lacks decision—making capacity, unless otherwise specified in the psychiatric advance directive.
