HB 1590-S2 - DIGEST

(DIGEST AS ENACTED)

Declares that the act of breastfeeding or expressing breast milk is not indecent exposure.

Provides that an employer may use the designation "infant-friendly" on its promotional materials if the employer has an approved workplace breastfeeding policy addressing at least the following:

- (1) Flexible work scheduling, including scheduling breaks and permitting work patterns that provide time for expression of breast milk;
- (2) A convenient, sanitary, safe, and private location, other than a restroom, allowing privacy for breastfeeding or expressing breast milk;
- (3) A convenient clean and safe water source with facilities for washing hands and rinsing breast-pumping equipment located in the private location specified in this act; and
- (4) A convenient hygienic refrigerator in the workplace for the mother's breast milk.
