## HB 1590 - DIGEST

## (SUBSTITUTED FOR - SEE 2ND SUB)

Declares that the act of breastfeeding or expressing breast milk is not indecent exposure.

Provides that an employer may use the designation "motherfriendly" on its promotional materials if the employer has an approved workplace breastfeeding policy addressing at least the following:

(1) Flexible work scheduling, including scheduling breaks and permitting work patterns that provide time for expression of breast milk;

(2) A convenient, sanitary, safe, and private location, other than a restroom, allowing privacy for breastfeeding or expressing breast milk;

(3) A convenient clean and safe water source with facilities for washing hands and rinsing breast-pumping equipment; and

(4) A convenient hygienic refrigerator in the workplace for the mother's breast milk.
