HB 1836-S - DIGEST

(DIGEST AS ENACTED)

Provides that, by December 1, 2001, the task force established in this act must report and recommend to the legislature:

- (1) An analysis detailing current local park and recreation uses and trends;
- (2) An analysis detailing current funding for local park and recreation maintenance and operations;
- (3) An analysis of the benefits that local parks provide to the state;
- (4) An analysis of the anticipated future needs of local parks and recreation agencies, including utilization, maintenance, operations, and other needs identified; and
- (5) Recommended sources of funding to meet the operational needs of local parks and recreation agencies identified in the report.
