Brief Description: Allowing restaurants and private clubs to sell wine for off-premises consumption.

HB 1951 - DIGEST

(DIGEST AS ENACTED)

Provides that the board may issue an endorsement to the spirits, beer, and wine private club license that allows the holder of a spirits, beer, and wine private club license to sell for off-premises consumption wine vinted and bottled in the state of Washington and carrying a label exclusive to the license holder selling the wine.

Provides that the board may issue an endorsement to the private club beer and wine license that allows the holder of a private club beer and wine license to sell for off-premises consumption wine vinted and bottled in the state of Washington and carrying a label exclusive to the license holder selling the wine.

Provides that the board may issue an endorsement to the spirits, beer, and wine restaurant license that allows the holder of a spirits, beer, and wine restaurant license to sell for off-premises consumption wine vinted and bottled in the state of Washington and carrying a label exclusive to the license holder selling the wine.

Provides that spirits and beer may not be sold for offpremises consumption under this act. The annual fee for the endorsement under this act is one hundred twenty dollars.
