(AS OF HOUSE 2ND READING 3/12/01)

Declares that a rebuttable presumption that a child has suffered negligent treatment or maltreatment shall exist if, during investigation conducted by the department under this chapter or by law enforcement, a child is found in a place where methamphetamine is being manufactured.
