SB 5322-S - DIGEST

(DIGEST OF PROPOSED 1ST SUBSTITUTE)

Requires the department to establish and maintain a toll-free telephone number and electronic means for public access for the communication of information to the public regarding child day-care centers and family day-care providers.

Requires all licensed child day-care centers and family day-care providers to post in a place and manner clearly visible to patrons and visitors the department's toll-free telephone number. Parents or guardians must be given the department's toll-free telephone number by employees or operators of the child day-care centers and family day-care providers.
