Brief Description: Modifying the handling of beer and wine by employees eighteen to twenty-one years old.

SB 5929 - DIGEST

Provides that licensees holding grocery store or beer and/or wine specialty shop licenses exclusively are permitted to allow employees of the nonretail class liquor licensee between the ages of eighteen and twenty-one to stock merchandise or handle beer or wine on the retail licensee's premises as long as there is an adult twenty-one years of age or older, employed by the retail licensee, on duty supervising the activities on the licensee's premises, however, nothing shall be construed to permit a nonretail licensee's employee, between the ages of eighteen and twenty-one, to handle, transport, or otherwise possess beer or wine beyond the premises of the retail licensee.
