3 On page 2, strike lines 3 through 31, and insert:

4 "(2) The commission has seven members as follows:

5 (a) One member is the state auditor, who is a nonvoting member;

6 (b) One member is the chair of the joint legislative audit and
7 review committee, who is a nonvoting member;

8 (c) The chair of each of the two largest caucuses of the senate
9 and the two largest caucuses of the house of representatives shall
10 each appoint a member. None of these appointees may be members of
11 the legislature; and

12 (d) The governor shall select the seventh member.

13 (3) Persons appointed by the caucus chairs should be
14 individuals who represent a balance of perspectives and
15 constituencies, and have a basic understanding of state tax policy,
16 government operations, and public services. These appointees
17 should have knowledge and expertise in performance management,
18 fiscal analysis, strategic planning, economic development,
19 performance assessments, or closely related fields."

20 Renumber subsections and correct references accordingly.

21 On page 3, line 6, after "initial" strike everything through
22 "term" on line 8 and insert "terms, the members appointed by the
23 chairs of senate caucuses shall serve four-year terms, the members
24 appointed by chairs of house of representatives caucuses shall
25 serve three-year terms, and the member appointed by the governor
26 shall serve a two-year term"

EFFECT: Changes the membership to 7 members, and revises the
appointment procedure.
