3 On page 2, beginning on line 31, strike all of subsection (7)  
4 and insert the following:

5 (7) This chapter does not require an electrical contractor  
6 license if: (a) An appropriately certified electrician or a  
7 properly supervised certified electrical trainee is performing the  
8 installation, repair, or maintenance of wires and equipment for a  
9 nonprofit corporation that holds a current tax exempt status as  
10 provided under 26 U.S.C. Sec. 501 (c)(3) or a nonprofit religious  
11 organization; (b) the certified electrician or certified electrical  
12 trainee is not compensated for the electrical work; and (c) the  
13 value of the electrical work does not exceed thirty thousand  
14 dollars.-

**EFFECT:** Clarifies that an electrical contractor license is not required when a certified electrician or a certified electrical trainee is performing electrical work for a nonprofit corporation or a nonprofit religious organization, the electrician or trainee is not compensated for the electrical work, and the value of the work does not exceed a certain level. Changes the cap on the value of the work from \$200,000 for the project to \$30,000 for the electrical work.
