- 1 On page 10, line 33, after "(c)" insert the following:
- 2 "The employee has not already rendered a cumulative total of more
- 3 than (i) three thousand one hundred sixty-five hours of service as a
- 4 teacher, or (ii) one thousand nine hundred hours in any other capacity,
- 5 while receiving pension payments, beyond an annual threshold of eight
- 6 <u>hundred sixty-seven hours; and</u>
- 7 <u>(d)</u>
- 8 On page 10, line 35, after "audit;", strike everything through
- 9 "retirement." and insert the following:
- 10 "shall cease to receive pension payments while engaged in that service
- 11 after the retiree has rendered service for more than on thousand five
- 12 hundred hours in a school year. The cumulative total limitations under
- 13 this subsection apply prospectively to those retiring after the
- 14 <u>effective date of this act and retroactively to those who retired prior</u>
- 15 to the effective date of this act, and shall be calculated from the
- 16 date of retirement."
- 17 Renumber the sections consecutively and correct any internal
- 18 references accordingly.

**EFFECT:** Increases from 1,900 hours to 3,165 hours the lifetime cumulative limit on the hours that teachers' retirement system plan 1 retirees may work in excess of 867 hours per year as teachers while receiving pension benefits. For teachers working on a full-time basis, this extends the limit from three years to five years.
