1 Strike everything after the enacting clause and insert the  
2 following:

3 "NEW SECTION. **Sec. 1.** A new section is added to chapter 46.04 RCW  
4 to read as follows:

5 "Signal preemption device" means a device that is capable of  
6 altering the normal operation of a traffic control signal.

7 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 2.** A new section is added to chapter 46.61 RCW  
8 to read as follows:

9 (1) Signal preemption devices shall not be installed or used on or  
10 with any vehicle other than an emergency vehicle authorized by the  
11 state patrol, a publicly owned law enforcement or emergency vehicle, a  
12 department of transportation, city, or county maintenance vehicle, or  
13 a public transit vehicle.

14 (2) This section does not apply to any of the following:

15 (a) A law enforcement agency and law enforcement personnel in the  
16 course of providing law enforcement services;

17 (b) A fire station or a fire fighter in the course of providing  
18 fire prevention or fire extinguishing services;

19 (c) An emergency medical service or ambulance in the course of  
20 providing emergency medical transportation or ambulance services;

21 (d) An operator, passenger, or owner of an authorized emergency  
22 vehicle in the course of his or her emergency duties;

23 (e) Department of transportation, city, or county maintenance  
24 personnel while performing maintenance;

25 (f) Public transit personnel in the performance of their duties.

26 However, public transit personnel operating a signal preemption device  
27 shall have second degree priority to law enforcement personnel, fire  
28 fighters, emergency medical personnel, and other authorized emergency

1 vehicle personnel, when simultaneously approaching the same traffic  
2 control signal;

3 (g) A mail or package delivery service or employee or agent of a  
4 mail or package delivery service in the course of shipping or  
5 delivering a signal preemption device;

6 (h) An employee or agent of a signal preemption device manufacturer  
7 or retailer in the course of his or her employment in providing,  
8 selling, manufacturing, or transporting a signal preemption device to  
9 an individual or agency described in this subsection.

10 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 3.** A new section is added to chapter 46.61 RCW  
11 to read as follows:

12 (1) It is unlawful to possess a signal preemption device except as  
13 authorized in section 2 of this act.

14 (2) A person who violates this section is guilty of a misdemeanor.

15 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 4.** A new section is added to chapter 46.61 RCW  
16 to read as follows:

17 (1) It is unlawful to:

18 (a) Use a signal preemption device except as authorized in section  
19 2 of this act;

20 (b) Sell a signal preemption device to a person other than a person  
21 described in section 2 of this act; or

22 (c) Purchase a signal preemption device for use other than a duty  
23 as described in section 2 of this act.

24 (2) A person who violates this section is guilty of a gross  
25 misdemeanor.

26 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 5.** A new section is added to chapter 46.61 RCW  
27 to read as follows:

28 (1) When an accident that results only in injury to property or  
29 injury to a person that does not arise to substantial bodily harm as  
30 defined in RCW 9A.04.110 occurs as a proximate result of the operation  
31 of a signal preemption device which was not authorized in section 2 of  
32 this act, the driver is guilty of negligently causing an accident by  
33 use of a signal preemption device.

1 (2) Negligently causing an accident by use of a signal preemption  
2 device is a class C felony punishable under chapter 9A.20 RCW.

3 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 6.** A new section is added to chapter 46.61 RCW  
4 to read as follows:

5 (1) When an accident that results in injury to a person that arises  
6 to substantial bodily harm as defined in RCW 9A.04.110 occurs as a  
7 proximate result of the operation of a signal preemption device which  
8 was not authorized in section 2 of this act, the driver is guilty of  
9 negligently causing substantial bodily harm by use of a signal  
10 preemption device.

11 (2) Negligently causing substantial bodily harm by use of a signal  
12 preemption device is a class B felony punishable under chapter 9A.20  
13 RCW.

14 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 7.** A new section is added to chapter 46.61 RCW  
15 to read as follows:

16 (1) When an accident that results in death to a person occurs as a  
17 proximate result of the operation of a signal preemption device which  
18 was not authorized in section 2 of this act, the driver is guilty of  
19 negligently causing death by use of a signal preemption device.

20 (2) Negligently causing death by use of a signal preemption device  
21 is a class B felony punishable under chapter 9A.20 RCW.

22 **Sec. 8.** RCW 46.37.190 and 1993 c 401 s 2 are each amended to read  
23 as follows:

24 (1) Every authorized emergency vehicle shall, in addition to any  
25 other equipment and distinctive marking required by this chapter, be  
26 equipped with at least one lamp capable of displaying a red light  
27 visible from at least five hundred feet in normal sunlight and a siren  
28 capable of giving an audible signal.

29 (2) Every school bus and private carrier bus shall, in addition to  
30 any other equipment and distinctive markings required by this chapter,  
31 be equipped with a "stop" signal upon a background not less than  
32 fourteen by eighteen inches displaying the word "stop" in letters of  
33 distinctly contrasting colors not less than eight inches high, and  
34 shall further be equipped with signal lamps mounted as high and as

1 widely spaced laterally as practicable, which shall be capable of  
2 displaying to the front two alternately flashing red lights located at  
3 the same level and to the rear two alternately flashing red lights  
4 located at the same level and these lights shall have sufficient  
5 intensity to be visible at five hundred feet in normal sunlight.

6 (3) Vehicles operated by public agencies whose law enforcement  
7 duties include the authority to stop and detain motor vehicles on the  
8 public highways of the state may be equipped with a siren and lights of  
9 a color and type designated by the state patrol for that purpose. The  
10 state patrol may prohibit the use of these sirens and lights on  
11 vehicles other than the vehicles described in this subsection.

12 (4) The lights described in this section shall not be mounted nor  
13 used on any vehicle other than a school bus, a private carrier bus, or  
14 an authorized emergency or law enforcement vehicle. ~~((Optical strobe  
15 light devices shall not be installed or used on any vehicle other than  
16 an emergency vehicle authorized by the state patrol, a publicly owned  
17 law enforcement or emergency vehicle, a department of transportation,  
18 city, or county maintenance vehicle, or a public transit vehicle.~~

19 ~~(a) An "optical strobe light device" used by emergency vehicles  
20 means a strobe light device which emits an optical signal at a specific  
21 frequency to a traffic control light enabling the emergency vehicle in  
22 which the strobe light device is used to obtain the right of way at  
23 intersections.~~

24 ~~(b) An "optical strobe light device" used by department of  
25 transportation, city, or county maintenance vehicles means a strobe  
26 light device that emits an optical signal at a specific frequency to a  
27 traffic control light enabling the department of transportation  
28 maintenance vehicle in which the strobe light device is used to perform  
29 maintenance tests.~~

30 ~~(c) An "optical strobe light device" used by public transit  
31 vehicles means a strobe light device that emits an optical signal at a  
32 specific frequency to a traffic control light enabling the public  
33 transit vehicle in which the strobe light device is used to accelerate  
34 the cycle of the traffic control light. For the purposes of this  
35 section, "public transit vehicle" means vehicles, owned by a  
36 governmental entity, with a seating capacity for twenty five or more  
37 persons and used to provide mass transportation. Public transit~~

1 ~~vehicles operating an optical strobe light will have second degree~~  
2 ~~priority to emergency vehicles when simultaneously approaching the same~~  
3 ~~traffic control light.)~~)

4 (5) The use of the signal equipment described ((~~herein~~)) in this  
5 section and section 2 of this act, except the ((~~optical strobe light~~))  
6 signal preemption devices used by public transit vehicles and  
7 department of transportation, city, or county maintenance vehicles that  
8 are not used in conjunction with emergency equipment, shall impose upon  
9 drivers of other vehicles the obligation to yield right of way and stop  
10 as prescribed in RCW 46.61.210, 46.61.370, and 46.61.350.

11 **Sec. 9.** RCW 9.94A.515 and 2003 c 335 s 5, 2003 c 283 s 33, 2003 c  
12 267 s 3, 2003 c 250 s 14, 2003 c 119 s 8, 2003 c 53 s 56, and 2003 c 52
