**Background:** The Legislative Committee on Economic Development was created in 1985. Its purpose is to "provide responsive and consistent involvement by the legislature in economic development to maintain a healthy state economy and to provide employment opportunities to Washington residents." The authorizing legislation for the committee states that: "Economic development and in particular international trade, tourism, and investment have become increasingly important to Washington..." The name of the committee does not reflect this focus on international relations.

**Summary of Bill:** The name of the Legislative Committee on Economic Development is changed to the Legislative Committee on Economic Development and International Relations.

Appropriation: None.

**Effective Date:** Ninety days after adjournment of session in which bill is passed.
