- 1 AN ACT Relating to exempting the slaughter, preparation, and sale
- 2 of certain chickens from the state's food processing act; and amending
- 3 RCW 69.07.100.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 5 **Sec. 1.** RCW 69.07.100 and 2002 c 301 s 10 are each amended to read 6 as follows:
- 7 (1) The provisions of this chapter shall not apply to 8 establishments issued a permit or licensed under the provisions of:
- 9 $((\frac{1}{1}))$ (a) Chapter 69.25 RCW, the Washington wholesome eggs and 10 egg products act;
- 11 $((\frac{2}{2}))$ (b) Chapter 69.28 RCW, the Washington state honey act;
- 12 $((\frac{3}{)})$ (c) Chapter 16.49 RCW, the meat inspection act;
- 13 $((\frac{4}{1}))$ (d) Chapter 77.65 RCW, relating to the direct retail
- 14 endorsement for wild-caught seafood;
- 15 $((\frac{5}{}))$ (e) Title 66 RCW, relating to alcoholic beverage control;
- 16 and
- 17 $((\frac{(6)}{)})$ (f) Chapter 69.30 RCW, the <u>sanitary</u> control of shellfish

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act. However, if any such establishments process foods not specifically provided for in the above entitled acts, such establishments shall be subject to the provisions of this chapter.

- (2) The provisions of this chapter shall not apply to:
- (a) Restaurants or food service establishments; and

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(b) The slaughter and preparation of one thousand or fewer chickens
in a calendar year by the agricultural producer of the chickens for the
sale of the whole or cut-up raw chickens by the producer directly to
retail customers.

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
