- MEW SECTION. Sec. 1. A new section is added to chapter 9.41 RCW to read as follows:
  - (1) A person licensed to carry a handgun in any state the laws of which recognize and give effect in that state to a concealed pistol license issued under the laws of the state of Washington is authorized to carry a pistol in this state. This section applies to a license holder from another state only while the license holder is not a resident of this state. A license holder from another state must carry the handgun in compliance with the laws of this state.
- 13 (2) The attorney general shall periodically publish a list of 14 states the laws of which recognize and give effect in that state to a 15 concealed pistol license issued under the laws of the state of 16 Washington.
