- AN ACT Relating to expert witnesses in actions under chapter 7.70
- 2 RCW; and adding a new section to chapter 7.70 RCW.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- MEW SECTION. Sec. 1. A new section is added to chapter 7.70 RCW to read as follows:
- In any action under this chapter, each side shall presumptively be entitled to only one independent expert on an issue and only one
- 8 standard-of-care expert, except upon a showing of good cause. Where
- 9 there are multiple parties on a side and the parties cannot agree as to
- 10 which independent expert or standard-of-care expert will be called on
- 11 an issue, the court, upon a showing of good cause, shall allow more
- 12 than one independent expert on an issue or standard-of-care expert to
- 13 be called.
