1 AN ACT Relating to expert witnesses in actions under chapter 7.70 2 RCW; and adding a new section to chapter 7.70 RCW.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

4 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 1.** A new section is added to chapter 7.70 RCW 5 to read as follows:

In any action under this chapter, each side shall presumptively be 6 7 entitled to only one independent expert on an issue and only one 8 standard-of-care expert, except upon a showing of good cause. Where there are multiple parties on a side and the parties cannot agree as to 9 10 which independent expert or standard-of-care expert will be called on 11 an issue, the court shall designate the expert to be called or, upon a 12 showing of good cause, may allow more than one independent expert or 13 standard-of-care expert to be called.
