- 4 **Sec. 1.** RCW 47.05.022 and 2002 c 56 s 302 are each amended to read 5 as follows:
- 6 ((The legislature designates)) The following highways are of statewide significance:
- 8 (1) That portion of state route number 509 that runs or will run
 9 from state route number 518 in the north to the intersection with
 10 Interstate 5 in the south ((as a state highway of statewide
 11 significance));
- (2) That portion of state route number 6 that runs from a junction with state route number 101 at Raymond, thence easterly by way of Lebam and Pe Ell to a junction with state route number 5 at Chehalis.
