- 1 AN ACT Relating to insurance coverage for injuries sustained
- 2 because of alcohol or narcotic use; adding a new section to chapter
- 3 48.20 RCW; adding a new section to chapter 48.21 RCW; adding a new
- 4 section to chapter 48.44 RCW; adding a new section to chapter 48.46
- 5 RCW; creating new sections; and repealing RCW 48.20.272.
- 6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 7 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 1.** The legislature finds that an alcohol or
- 8 drug-related injury that requires treatment in an emergency department
- 9 can be a critical moment in the life of a person with a substance abuse
- 10 problem. Studies have demonstrated that appropriate interventions by
- 11 hospital staff at these times can reduce substance abuse and lower
- 12 future health care costs.
- 13 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 2.** A new section is added to chapter 48.20 RCW
- 14 to read as follows:
- 15 An insurer may not deny coverage for the treatment of an injury
- 16 solely because the injury was sustained as a consequence of the
- insured's being intoxicated or under the influence of a narcotic.

- 2 to read as follows:
- 3 An insurer may not deny coverage for the treatment of an injury
- 4 solely because the injury was sustained as a consequence of the
- 5 insured's being intoxicated or under the influence of a narcotic.
- 6 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 4.** A new section is added to chapter 48.44 RCW
- 7 to read as follows:
- 8 A health care service contractor may not deny coverage for the
- 9 treatment of an injury solely because the injury was sustained as a
- 10 consequence of the enrolled participant's being intoxicated or under
- 11 the influence of a narcotic.
- 12 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 5.** A new section is added to chapter 48.46 RCW
- 13 to read as follows:
- 14 A health maintenance organization may not deny coverage for the
- 15 treatment of an injury solely because the injury was sustained as a
- 16 consequence of the enrolled participant's being intoxicated or under
- 17 the influence of a narcotic.
- NEW SECTION. Sec. 6. RCW 48.20.272 (Optional standard provision
- 19 No. 23--Intoxicants and narcotics) and 1951 c 229 s 28 are each
- 20 repealed.
- 21 NEW SECTION. Sec. 7. This act applies to all contracts issued or
- 22 renewed on or after the effective date of this act.
