1 AN ACT Relating to dangerous or potentially dangerous dogs; and 2 adding a new section to chapter 16.08 RCW.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

4 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> Sec. 1. A new section is added to chapter 16.08 RCW 5 to read as follows:

6 (1) The breed of a dog shall not be a determining factor when 7 declaring a dog potentially dangerous or dangerous.

8 (2) A dog may not be considered potentially dangerous or dangerous 9 if the dog's threatening behavior or infliction of injury or damage was 10 sustained by a person who, at the time, was:

(a) Committing a willful trespass or other tort upon the premisesoccupied by the owner of the dog;

(b) Tormenting, abusing, or assaulting the dog or has, in the past,
been observed or reported to have tormented, abused, or assaulted the
dog; or

16 (c) Committing or attempting to commit a crime.
