1 AN ACT Relating to the membership of the state building code 2 council; and amending RCW 19.27.070.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

4 **Sec. 1.** RCW 19.27.070 and 1995 c 399 s 8 are each amended to read 5 as follows:

6 There is hereby established a state building code council to be 7 appointed by the governor.

(1) The state building code council shall consist of fifteen 8 members, two of whom shall be county elected legislative body members 9 10 or elected executives and two of whom shall be city elected legislative body members or mayors. One of the members shall be a local government 11 12 building code enforcement official, and one of the members shall be a local government fire service official. Of the remaining nine members, 13 14 one member shall represent general construction, specializing in 15 commercial and industrial building construction; one member shall represent general construction, specializing in residential 16 and multifamily building construction; one member shall represent the 17 architectural design profession; one member shall represent the 18 19 structural engineering profession; one member shall represent the

mechanical engineering profession; one member shall represent the 1 2 construction building trades; one member shall represent manufacturers, installers, or suppliers of building materials and components; one 3 member shall be a person with a physical disability and shall represent 4 the disability community; and one member shall represent the general 5 public. At least six of these fifteen members shall reside east of the 6 crest of the Cascade mountains. The council shall also include: 7 Two members of the house of representatives appointed by the speaker of the 8 house, one from each caucus; two members of the senate appointed by the 9 10 president of the senate, one from each caucus; the state director of fire protection; and an employee of the electrical division of the 11 12 department of labor and industries, as ex officio, nonvoting members 13 with all other privileges and rights of membership. Terms of office shall be for three years. The council shall elect a member to serve as 14 chair of the council for one-year terms of office. Any member who is 15 appointed by virtue of being an elected official or holding public 16 17 employment shall be removed from the council if he or she ceases being such an elected official or holding such public employment. Before 18 making any appointments to the building code council, the governor 19 shall seek nominations from recognized organizations which represent 20 21 the entities or interests listed in this subsection. Members serving on the council on July 28, 1985, may complete their terms of office. 22 Any vacancy shall be filled by alternating appointments from 23 24 governmental and nongovernmental entities or interests until the council is constituted as required by this subsection. 25

26 (2) Members shall not be compensated but shall receive 27 reimbursement for travel expenses in accordance with RCW 43.03.050 and 28 43.03.060.

(3) The department of community, trade, and economic development shall provide administrative and clerical assistance to the building code council.

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
