1 AN ACT Relating to the use of day-time running lights at night; and
2 amending RCW 46.37.020.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

4 **Sec. 1.** RCW 46.37.020 and 1977 ex.s. c 355 s 2 are each amended to
5 read as follows:

6 (1) Every vehicle upon a highway within this state at any time from
7 a half hour after sunset to a half hour before sunrise and at any other
8 time when, due to insufficient light or unfavorable atmospheric
9 conditions, persons and vehicles on the highway are not clearly
10 discernible at a distance of one thousand feet ahead shall display
11 lighted head lights, other lights, and illuminating devices as
12 hereinafter respectively required for different classes of vehicles,
13 subject to exceptions with respect to parked vehicles, and such stop
14 lights, turn signals, and other signaling devices shall be lighted as
15 prescribed for the use of such devices.

16 (2) When lighted head lights, other lights, and illuminating
17 devices are required under subsection (1) of this section, the use of

1 day-time running lights is prohibited.
