AN ACT Relating to traffic control signal preemption devices; amending RCW 46.63.020; adding a new section to chapter 46.61 RCW; adding a new section to chapter 46.04 RCW; and prescribing penalties.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

5 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> Sec. 1. A new section is added to chapter 46.61 RCW 6 to read as follows:

7 (1) It is unlawful for any person, other than the owner or operator
8 of an authorized emergency vehicle or a municipal transit vehicle, to
9 sell, own, or use a traffic control signal preemption device.

10 (2) Violation of subsection (1) of this section is a gross 11 misdemeanor.

12 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 2.** A new section is added to chapter 46.04 RCW 13 to read as follows:

14 "Traffic control signal preemption device" means a device that 15 interferes with or alters the operation of a traffic control signal.

16 Sec. 3. RCW 46.63.020 and 2003 c 33 s 4 are each amended to read 17 as follows:
