- AN ACT Relating to city assumption of water-sewer districts; and adding a new section to chapter 35.13A RCW.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- MEW SECTION. Sec. 1. A new section is added to chapter 35.13A RCW to read as follows:
- A city may not assume, under this chapter, the jurisdiction of all or part of a water-sewer district serving a population greater than five thousand residents and containing, within its boundaries, the
- 9 territory of two or more cities, or one city and unincorporated
- 10 territory, unless voters of the entire water-sewer district approve a
- 11 ballot proposition authorizing the assumption under general election
- 12 law. The cost of the election shall be borne by the city seeking
- 13 approval to assume jurisdiction of a water-sewer district.
