1            AN ACT Relating to cancer registry information; amending RCW  
2 70.54.240; and providing an effective date.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

4            **Sec. 1.** RCW 70.54.240 and 1990 c 280 s 3 are each amended to read  
5 as follows:

6            (1) The department of health shall adopt rules as to which types of  
7 cancer shall be reported, who shall report, and the form and timing of  
8 the reports.

9            (2) Every health care facility and independent clinical laboratory,  
10 and those physicians or others providing health care who diagnose or  
11 treat any patient with cancer who is not hospitalized within one month  
12 of diagnosis, will provide the contractor with the information required  
13 under subsection (1) of this section. The required information may be  
14 collected on a regional basis where such a system exists and forwarded  
15 to the contractor in a form suitable for the purposes of RCW 70.54.230  
16 through 70.54.270. Such reporting arrangements shall be reduced to a  
17 written agreement between the contractor and any regional reporting  
18 agency which shall detail the manner, form, and timeliness of the  
19 reporting.

1       (3) Upon receipt of information to be incorporated into the  
2 registry data base, the contractor or subcontractor responsible for  
3 entering the information shall mail to the address provided for each  
4 cancer patient printed information describing the purpose of the cancer  
5 registry program; the collection, use, distribution, and  
6 confidentiality of the information; and other information that the  
7 department deems necessary.

8       NEW SECTION. Sec. 2. This act takes effect July 1, 2005.

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
