- 4 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 1.** A new section is added to chapter 43.06 RCW 5 to read as follows:
- 6 When requested by the governor or the director of the department of
- 8 shall be conducted through the Washington state patrol identification

personnel, nonconviction criminal history fingerprint record checks

- 9 and criminal history section and the federal bureau of investigation on
- 10 applicants for agency head positions appointed by the governor.
- 11 Information received pursuant to this section shall be confidential and
- 12 made available only to the governor or director of the department of
- 13 personnel or their employees directly involved in the selection,
- 14 hiring, or background investigation of the subject of the record check.
- 15 When necessary, applicants may be employed on a conditional basis
- 16 pending completion of the criminal history record check. "Agency head"
- 17 as used in this section has the same definition as provided in RCW
