1 AN ACT Relating to off-campus disruptive behavior of higher 2 education students; and adding a new section to chapter 28B.10 RCW.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

MEW SECTION. **Sec. 1.** A new section is added to chapter 28B.10 RCW to read as follows:

- 6 (1) Each institution of higher education shall adopt rules 7 regarding disruptive off-campus conduct of students, including 8 sanctions.
- 9 (2) Sanctions may include, but are not limited to, counseling, 10 probation, suspension, or expulsion.
- 11 (3) As used in this section, "disruptive off-campus conduct" means 12 any conduct that results in a citation or conviction for the violation 13 of laws or ordinances and that:
- 14 (a) Interferes with the institution of higher education's relationship with the surrounding community;
- 16 (b) Harms the reputation of the institution of higher education; or
- 17 (c) Violates the institution of higher education's policies.
- 18 (4) Each institution of higher education shall report the substance

- 1 of the rules adopted under this section to the higher education
- 2 committees of the legislature by December 1, 2004.
