1 AN ACT Relating to civil liability reform; and adding a new section 2 to chapter 7.72 RCW.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

<u>NEW SECTION.</u> Sec. 1. A new section is added to chapter 7.72 RCW
to read as follows:

(1) Any manufacturer, distributor, or seller of a food 6 or 7 nonalcoholic beverage intended for human consumption shall not be 8 subject to civil liability for personal injury or wrongful death based on an individual's consumption of food or nonalcoholic beverages in 9 10 cases where liability is premised upon the individual's weight gain, obesity, or a health condition related to weight gain or obesity and 11 12 resulting from the individual's long-term consumption of a food or nonalcoholic beverage. 13

14 (2) For the purposes of this section, the term "long-term 15 consumption" means the cumulative effect of the consumption of food or 16 nonalcoholic beverages, and not the effect of a single instance of 17 consumption. 1 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> Sec. 2. If any provision of this act or its 2 application to any person or circumstance is held invalid, the 3 remainder of the act or the application of the provision to other 4 persons or circumstances is not affected.
